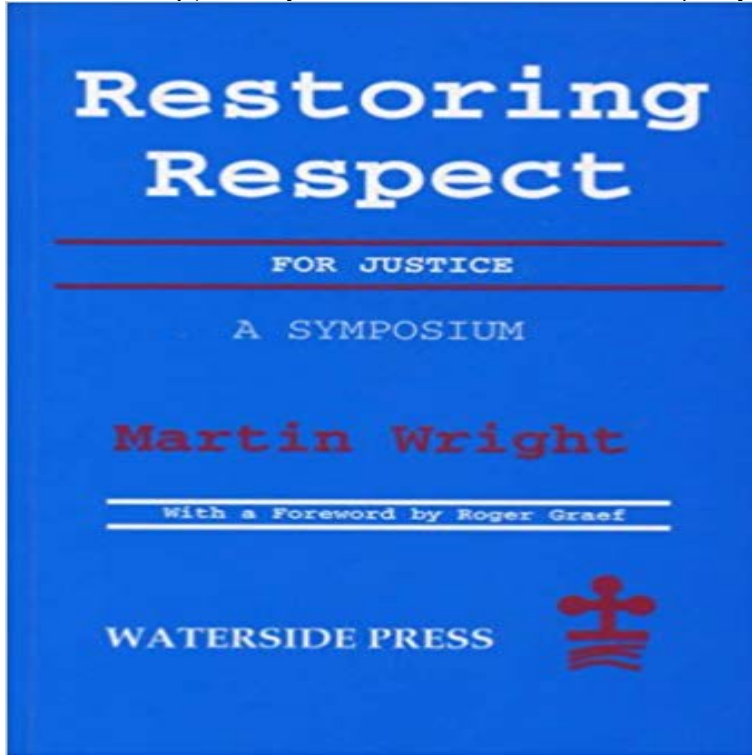


Restoring Respect for Justice: A Symposium
