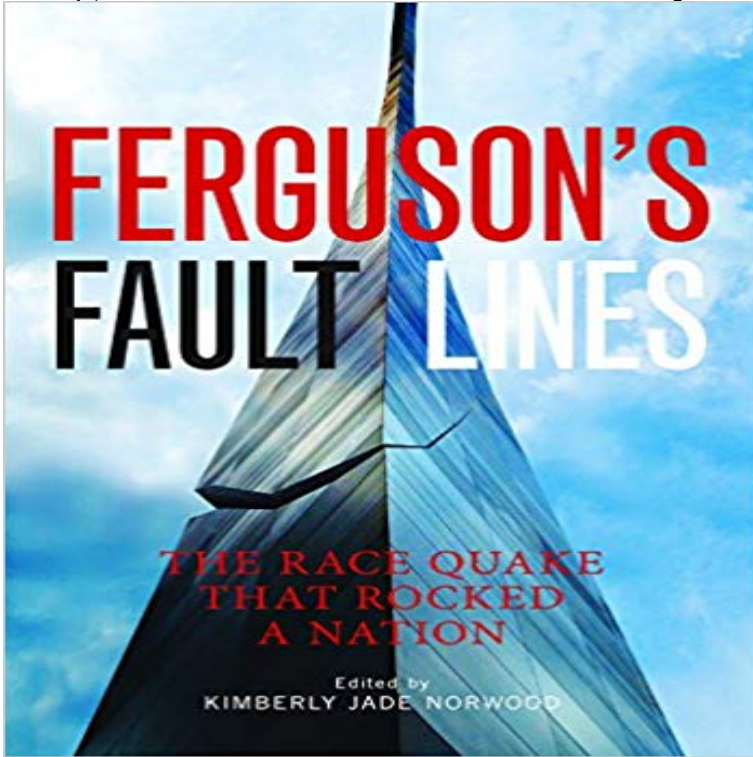


Fergusons Fault Lines: The Race Quake That Rocked a Nation
