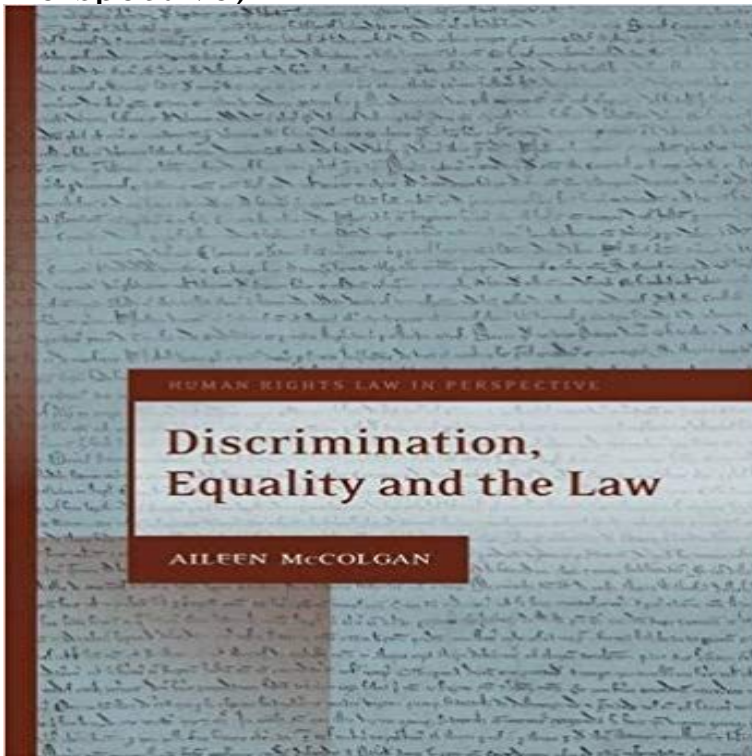


# Discrimination, Equality and the Law (Human Rights Law in Perspective)
