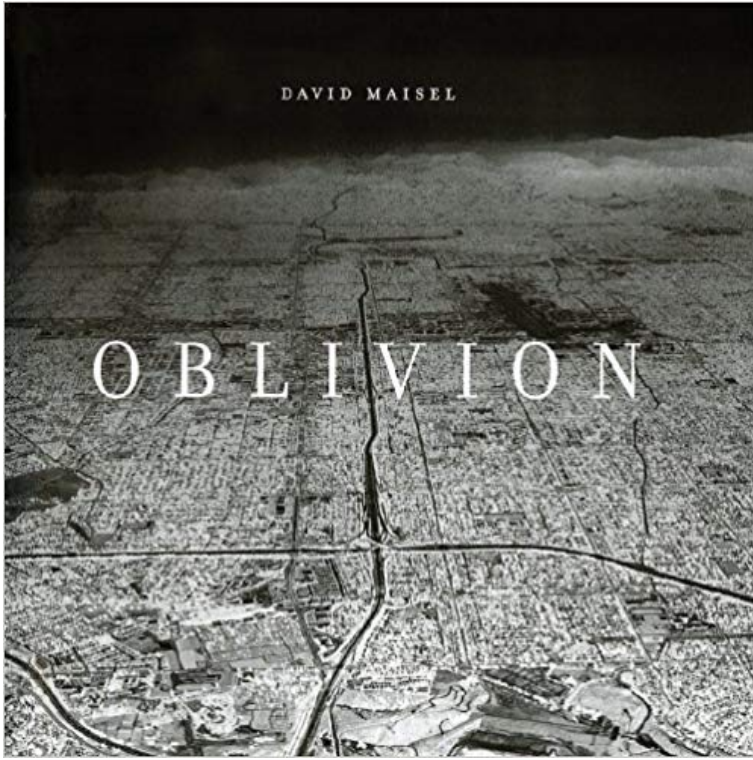


Oblivion
