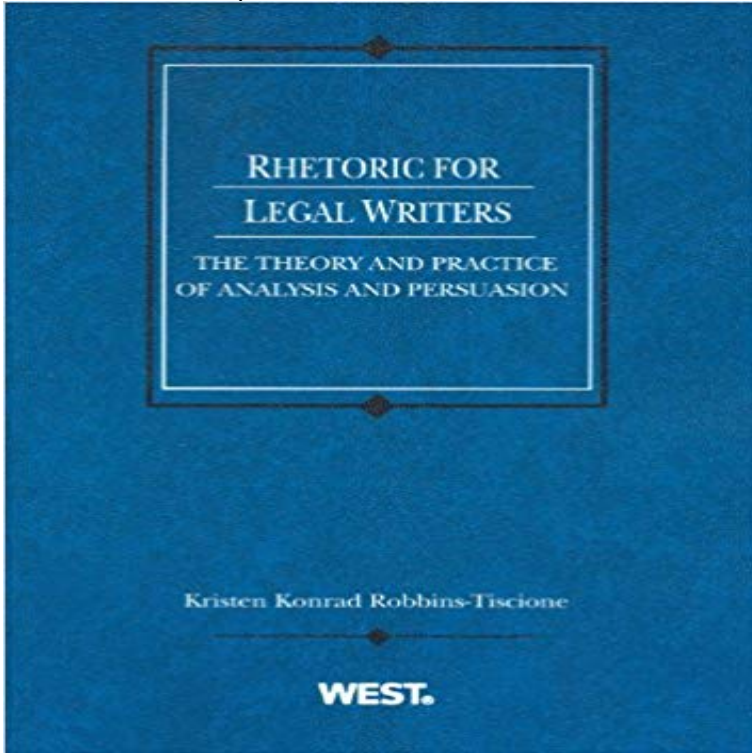


# Rhetoric for Legal Writers: The Theory and Practice of Analysis and Persuasion (American Casebook Series)

The second section, organized by the canons of classical rhetoric, discusses practical applications of rhetorical theory to the specific task of learning to think and write like a lawyer in the twenty-first century. By fusing theory and practice, a legal writer acquires depth?the ability to analyze an issue effectively using all available resources?as well as breadth?the ability to transfer her talent from one context to another. Each chapter includes questions for consideration by the students as well as samples exercises and suggested answers.
