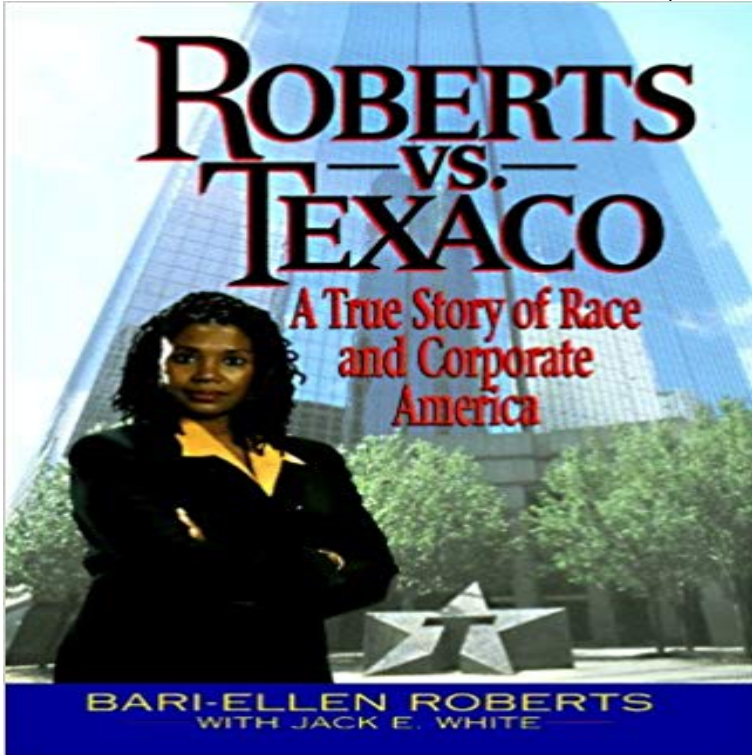


# Roberts Vs. Texaco:: A True Story Of Race And Corporate America
